These programs enable PSiSC® to be a good steward of our environment. PSiSC® has proven its commitment to meet the demand for environmental responsibility and sustainability in accordance with the USGBC® LEED® Program.

The LEED® Rating System Version 2.2 Certification Program, is a voluntary program developed by the USGBC® as a standard for developing environmentally responsible, low emission and sustainable buildings. The LEED® Rating System is designed to guide and distinguish high-performance commercial and institutional projects, including office buildings, high-rise residential buildings, government buildings, schools, recreational facilities and manufacturing plants. Individual products and materials used in these buildings are not certified but when properly selected, may contribute to the entire project's certification.

COLUMBIA PHENOLIC® and COLUMBIA TERRA CORE® are GREENGUARD INDOOR AIR QUALITY CERTIFIED® and are comprised of 72% paper from cellulose. The cellulose comes from trees that are Rapidly Renewable and are FSC-certified wood products. These products have a 28% Recycled Content and may contribute Certification Points for New Construction, Existing Buildings and Schools in the following categories:

MR Credit 4.1 or 4.2: Recycled Content: MR 4.1 = 10% (post-consumer + 1/2 pre-consumer) = 1 Point, MR 4.2 = 20% (post consumer + 1/2 pre-consumer) = 1 Additional Point. 2 Possible Points.

MR Credit 5.1 or 5.2: Regional Materials: MR 5.1 = 10% Extracted, Processed & Manufactured Regionally = 1 Point, MR 5.2 = 20% Extracted, Processed & Manufactured Regionally = 1 Additional Point. 2 Possible Points.

MR Credit 6: Rapidly Renewable Materials = 1 Point. 1 Possible Point.

MR Credit 7: Certified Wood: Use a minimum of 50% of wood-based products, which are certified in accordance with the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC®) = 1 Point. 1 Possible Point.

EQ Credit 4.4: Low-Emitting Materials: Composite Wood & Agrifiber Products used on the interior of the building shall contain no added urea-formaldehyde resins = 1 Point. 1 Possible Point.

PSiSC® uses **100% Post-Consumer Recycled HDPE** for all of our PolyLife® products. HDPE stands for High Density Polyethylene and is the plastic most commonly used for the packaging of products such as milk, detergent and juice. The recycled content of COLUMBIA POLYLIFE® - 100% Post-Consumer Recycled Toilet Partitions and Lockers is gathered from curb side collection points across the United States. These materials are washed, reprocessed into quality resin and then fabricated into PolyLife® Sheets.

The Toilet Partitions and Lockers are manufactured at **PSiSC**® plants located in Columbia, SC and Holbrook, AZ. These locations will allow most projects in the U.S. to earn credits for utilizing building materials or products that have been regionally extracted, harvested or **recovered**, as well as **manufactured** within 500 miles of the project site.

COLUMBIA POLYLIFE® Series 19000, 29000, 39000 and 49000 - 100% Post-Consumer Recycled Toilet Partitions and Lockers may contribute Certification Points for New Construction, Existing Buildings and Schools in the following categories:

MR Credit 2.1 or 2.2: Construction Waste Management: MR 2.1 = Divert 50% from Disposal = 1 Point, MR 2.2 = Divert 75% from Disposal = 1 Additional Point. 2 Possible Points.

MR Credit 4.1 or 4.2: Recycled Content: MR 4.1 = 10% (post-consumer + ½ pre-consumer) = 1 Point, MR 4.2 = 20% (post-consumer + ½ pre-consumer) = 1 Additional Point. 2 Possible Points.

MR Credit 5.1 or 5.2: Regional Materials: MR 5.1 = 10% Extracted, Processed & Manufactured Regionally = 1 Point, MR 5.2 = 20% Extracted, Processed & Manufactured Regionally = 1 Additional Point. 2 Possible Points.

COLUMBIA STAINLESS STEEL® Series 90000 and 95000 – Toilet Partitions have 67% recycled content and may contribute Certification Points for New Construction, Existing Buildings and Schools in the following categories:

MR Credit 4.1 or 4.2: Recycled Content: MR 4.1 = 10% (post-consumer + ½ pre-consumer) = 1 Point, MR 4.2 = 20% (post-consumer + ½ pre-consumer) = 1 Additional Point. 2 Possible Points.

EQ Credit 4.1: Low-Emitting Materials: Adhesives and Sealants: If the VOC content of the adhesive used is less than that established by the SCAQMD Rule #1168 = 1 Point. 1 Possible Point.

EQ Credit 4.4: Low-Emitting Materials: Composite Wood & Agrifiber Products used on the interior of the building shall contain no added urea-formaldehyde resins = 1 Point. 1 Possible Point.
